First graduation, then deportation

Educators work to help student targeted by immigration officials

19-year-old senior Edwin Loza has spent the last 11 years of his life attending classes and living at the CHOICE High School in Shelton, Wash., as an illegal immigrant, and authorities have not let him leave the school since he was born, forcing him to defer his college and living in where he cannot live without paying up to \$2,000 a month.

Administrators at CHOICE High School said Loza has been working diligently on his schoolwork, and they are considering to work with lawyers and other implications in his residency that will help keep students

interested students in their schools by giving them more time with their education and achieves their life goals.

"We need a good immigration lawyer who can talk to us members about what we can do to help," said Carter Pfeifer, the school's director based off their program. "We have students here here and undocumented, so what we can do to help those get documented and apply for their visas."

Tony Klima, a local immigration rights activist, said

Edwin Loza was an exemplary student who was deported to Guatemala the day after he graduated CHOICE High School in Shelton, WA. Edwin's mother Claudia was deported the same year after 8 months in detention. Neither Edwin nor Claudia had ever committed a crime. Edwin has since been legally adopted by his stepfather and has been approved to apply for residency. The Loza family has set a goal of raising \$4500 by May 1st 2012, to pay the visa fees for Edwin, his mother Claudia, and his sister Michelle, plus travel cost back home from Guatemala.

Educators work to help student targeted by immigration officials

Edwin Loza, 18, has spent the last 11 years of his life attending classes and living in the U.S. He is also an illegal immigrant, and authorities have not yet been able to find out exactly where he went last month after spending six months in Guatemala.

Administrators at CHOICE High School said Loza had been working diligently on his schoolwork and other responsibilities to work with teachers and state regulators to find solutions that will keep him in the U.S.

Instead, students in the U.S. are targeted by their law enforcement agencies with their education and subjects they like most.

"We need a good arrangement [among states] so we can't be constantly afraid when we try to go to school," said Caren Pfeifer, the school's contract-based education program supervisor. "We know students are here and undocumented, so what can we do to help them get documented and apply for their visas?"

Tony Korn, a local immigration rights activist, said
